- “And ask forgiveness of your Lord, then turn to Him. Surely my Lord is Merciful, Loving.” — 11:90
- “Surely He it is Who creates first and reproduces; and He is the Forgiving, the Loving, Lord of the Throne of Power, the Glorious, Doer of what He intends.” — 85:13-16
- “And when those who believe in Our messages come to you (O Prophet), say: Peace be on you, your Lord has ordained mercy on Himself, (so) that if anyone of you does evil in ignorance, then turns after that and acts aright, then He is Forgiving, Merciful.” — 6:54
- “Allah may forgive you, and He is the most Merciful of those who show mercy.” — 12:92
- “Our Lord, You embrace all things in mercy and knowledge, so protect those who turn (to You) and follow Your way, and save them from the punishment of hell.” — 40:7
- “In the grace of Allah and in His mercy, in that they should rejoice. It is better than what they hoard.” — 10:58
- “Surely Allah is Compassionate, Merciful, to the people.” — 2:143
- “Surely Allah is gracious to people, but most people are not grateful.” — 2:243
- “Say (O Prophet to people): If you love Allah, follow me: Allah will love you, and grant you protection from your sins. And Allah is Forgiving, Merciful.” — 3:31
